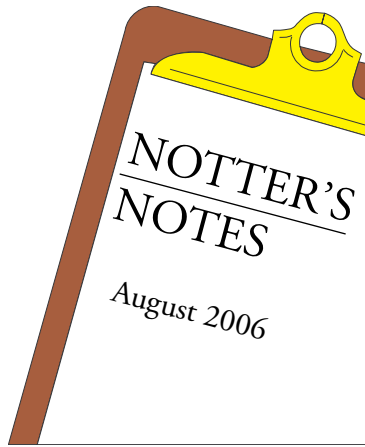

HUNTING SEASON IS CLOSER THAN YOU THINK

Now is the time to sight in/practice with that rifle or bring your bird gun and shoot trap. You cannot practice too much. The more you shoot before the season, the better you will do.

Always put your target frame away and clean your shooting area when through shooting.

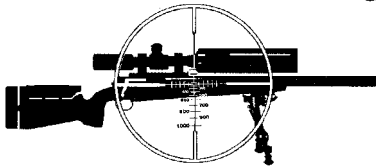
