■PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Dear Members,

Another month has gone by and I must say we are moving along toward a better quality range. Kenneith Notter and Frank Alessio were given the assignment of counting the votes regarding the Range Improvement Project, allocating the money to be spent for rebuilding the pistol range and building the new longer rifle range. Members returned 46.5% of the ballots mailed out. The vote results are as follows: YES = 503, NO = 13, Unusable

= 63. Unusable ballots were ballots returned unmarked and/or unsigned. Only complete and signed ballots are legally usable. We would like to commend everyone for a good return in voting. Thank you, Frank and Kenneith for doing the counting.

Proceeding with the Range Improvement Project, the first phase is clearing the grounds for building a berm between the 100 yard rifle range and the new longer range. I realize closing the range July 14 through July 17, from 7am to 4pm was on short notice. I have asked before, bear with us as we progress with each phase on completing the new longer range. There will be more times the range will be closed for a period as we build the new berm. We will try as best we can on minimizing the closure time. We, the BOD, really appreciate your patience. If any of the members have any questions, feel free to contact any of the Board of Directors and we will try to get an answer for you. Thank you again for your patience and understanding.

I will briefly touch on a few other items in case some of you were unable to attend the General meeting. Target frames will be supplied by the Association. There is an approved design from the BOD for the target frames. There will be frames available for purchasing from Doug Mitchell for a minimal cost. If you choose to build your own frames, they must be made of wood only and within the approved design set forth by the Board of Directors. There will be NO PVC allowed in the frames. If you have further questions regarding the construction of the frames, please contact a BOD member.

In addition, please keep the targets within the center of the frames. We have way too many shooters who are destroying the target frames by stapling the target to the framework. I ask each and every one of you too help control this problem and assist other shooters.

A reminder to members who bring guest under the age of 18, other than your own children. If you bring children under the age of 18, with the intent to shoot any firearm on Association property,

YOU MUST HAVE WRITTEN PERMISSION FROM THAT JUNIOR'S PARENT **OR LEGAL GUARDIAN IN YOUR POSSESSION.** There will be approved forms available either on the website or at the range. Remember, they must be signed prior to arriving on the Association property.

Our next work party is scheduled for the October 18, 2008. I encourage each and every one of you to consider helping clean our range. Let keep our range the best there is.



The upcoming election (November) will be important. Be sure that you are registered to vote & vote.


THANKS FOR THE HELP AT THE JUNIOR SHOOT




