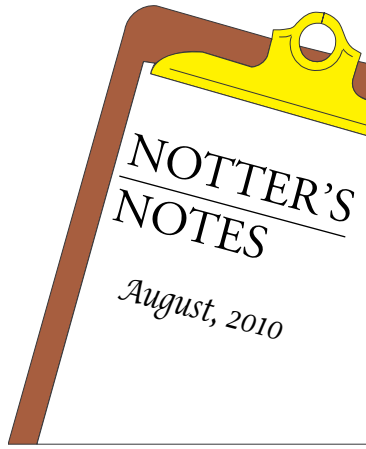

R A N G E M A S T E R S O U N D O F F

July started our new fiscal and membership year at the Association. Our Range Safety Officers' will be asking everybody for their membership card and photo identification. We appreciate your cooperation in this regard. Remember, there is a new gate code and you must enter the "#" sign first.

A reminder - a member can have only two (2) guests, must be with their guests at all times (exception would be a trip to the restroom) and monitor their guests shooting. We have had several instances lately where a member has brought in more than two guests and that puts the RSO's in a bad light when the RSO advises that they could not shoot. If you wish to bring more than two guests for a day at the range, please contact the Association Secretary for approval. The appropriate Range Safety Officer will be advised so there should be no issues.

The shotgun patterning stand has been used a lot and I have received many positive comments. A review of the requirements for use of the patterning stand follows:

- Pistol Range and Trap Range **MUST BE COLD** (not in use).
- Shotguns only.
- Non-lead (steel) shot is not allowed. Lead shot larger than #4; e.g. #2, #00 and larger is not allowed. Take a close look at the top section of the stand. You will see several large dents made by "00" buckshot and a bunch of small craters that look to be made from steel shot.
- Trap Master must approve use during scheduled trap functions.
- Report any malfunctions or damage to the stand to a Trap Master.

Basic Instructions

- Lift front handle and pull paper down to bottom bar.
- Use clips to hold paper on sides. If windy, clip to bottom bar.
- Use black marker to place a 3 inch circle in center of paper. Marker is "velcroed" to bottom of the paper holder.
- Aim and shoot at the 3 inch circle. There are cement markers at 30, 35 and 40 yards.
- Unclip and tear paper cleanly at the top bar.
- Leave clips on the side bars.
- Study your pattern at the tables or in Trap Ramada, not in the field.

If you have a black home defense shotgun or a coach shotgun, it probably does not have a choke and will produce a really wide pattern in a short distance. Please do not stand farther back than the 30 yard marker if you are trying to check the pattern on one of these shotguns.

We have reviewed shooting at 7 yards and any other close distance on the pistol range. The Board of Directors has discussed the situation and decided to **not allow shooting at distances shorter than 15 yards on the pistol range**. Please center your target on the 24" x 24" cardboard, with no more than two (2) targets aligned close together vertically (as long as the lower target does not allow bullets to skip on the ground) or close together horizontally. Aligning target horizontally and not close together, tends to get the frame uprights "shot", shortening frame life. The on-duty Range Safety Officers' do check target placement to make sure bullets are hitting the impact berm and not skipping off the ground and over the hill; which has happened.

Range Safety Tip of the Month - The vehicle speed limit on the Association property is 5 miles per hour and it is posted near the entryway. Please drive slowly, there are adults and children walking about and we do not want anyone hurt. Summer is in full swing so be on the lookout for our friend Mr. Diamond Back. He can be quite cranky and has been known to bite. I do not recall a problem with him on the range property recently, but be aware that they are out there.

Attention Active Duty RSO's, Trap Masters and Shoot Chairs – Range Master Appreciation Day is scheduled for all Sunday, 19 September 2010, from 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Fun, food and prizes.

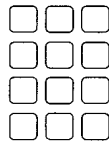

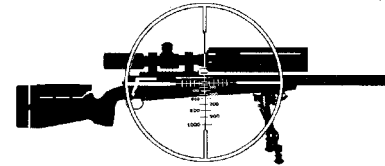
