
...which brings me to my next point.

### Specifications of Maintenance Duties- Revised, December 7, 2010

### A. Mowing Schedule

Mowing is to be performed as needed in compliance with the following schedule:

- 1. Rifle Range: Twice a month, normally the 1st and 4th weekends.
- Pistol Range: Once a month, normally for the 2<sup>nd</sup> weekend. Weeds on top of the bank and around target butts to be trimmed at the same time.
- Traps: Once a month, to be done for major shoots (Turkey shoot, BBQ, Etc.). Trim weeds around traps and pads.
- 4. Remaining Grounds: Once a month in conjunction with major events.

It will be necessary to check the monthly club calendar as the above schedule prepares the range for shoots as they are normally scheduled. Holidays and special events at times necessitate a change in the above schedule.

### B. Clean-Up

Trash cans are to be emptied as needed. Debris around Ramada's, traps and grounds to be picked up as needed. Must be able to lift 70 pounds.

- C. EF&GA will supply equipment and fuel necessary to perform above work. Contractor to supply fuels and get reimbursed.
- D. Compensation
  - 1. Payment to be made monthly upon satisfactory completion of work as listed above.
  - 2. Position subject to cancellation for unsatisfactory performance.

### E. Maintenance

Shall perform minor electrical and plumbing repairs and range maintenance as needed. Routine maintenance (oil change, belt replacement, etc.) will be performed by contractor. Major repairs will be the responsibility of EF&GA.

F. EF&GA Representative

EF&GA to be represented by the Project Manager or the President regarding matters such as actual mowing schedule, satisfactory performance, equipment repairs, etc.

### List of Requirements For Maintenance Position

- Must be a valid United States Citizen
- 2. Must be able to read and follow directions as necessary
- Must have basic Electrical and Mechanical knowledge
- Must be able to identify and work flexible hours to maximize work down range when ranges are available.
- Must have excellent operating skills in the operation of farm and landscaping machinery and equipment.
- Is required to maintain EFGA tools and equipment as well as schedule equipment servicing.
- 7. Must maintain an excellent relationship with those using the facilities
- Is expected to know the requirements and restrictions stipulated in the lease agreement with the city regarding proper use and discharge of chemicals, paints, and cleaning materials on the site.
- Must have working knowledge of proper soils distribution and management of the grounds



### **MUZZLELOADING RIFLE CLASS**

# RANGEMASTER SOUND OFF



A reminder – Be careful out there. It has warmed up and Mr. Diamond Back (a rattle snake) will be coming out. I do not know of a sighting so far this year, but that can change in a heartbeat. I have posted at each range a poster from the State of California that details information regarding the snakes. Please take time to read.

Friday, 01 July, was the beginning of EF&GA's new membership year. If you returned the renewal application and proper amount of dues by the deadline, you should have received a reply with the gate code sticker enclosed. Please place that gate code sticker on your membership card in the same area as the old silver colored one.

With the above gate code sticker in mind, please have your current membership card and a photo identification (California drivers' license works) when you visit the range. *I have asked the Range Safety Officers' to check everyone that is at the range*. You may get asked more than once to due Range Safety Officer shift overlaps or more than one Range Safety Officer working that day. If you have not received the new credentials by now, contact the EF&GA Clerk.

If you are a trap shooter and do not have the current credentials, you have to pay the "guest" rate for a round of trap. The Trap Masters' should be checking everyone that is signing up for a round of trap as well. I realize this can create a problem for our long standing members that the Trap Masters' know, but bear with us. Not quite my "What the ..." for this month, but during Tuesday morning trap, a shooter insisted they were a member and just could not understand why they had not received their new stuff: After all, they mailed everything back to the Clerk last week.

I held a target frame building party Friday, 24 June. The lucky party animals (no offense meant) were Larry Jeffrey, Scott Kendall (had no choice), Steve Willer and myself. We managed to build, using new lumber and good parts from shot up target frames, about 80 tall frames and 12 short prone frames (for the 150 yard range). The last frame party was in February and we built about 75 frames at that time. Doing the math, we went through, lost due to those pesky copper/lead termites, approximately 5 frames a week. Most of the frames that the 'termites' eat up were on the Pistol Range.

My "What the..." for August. As most of you know, we built a small sand "speed bump" down around the 35 yard line at the Pistol Range. A member had mounted their targets down low, really low requiring a new cardboard backing. Their bullets were being shot right into the "speed bump". When the Range Safety Officer stopped their shooting and asked why they we shooting into the "speed bump"; they replied "that's what it is there for". They were educated on proper target placement.

• Range Safety Tip of the Month. Without sounding too Draconian, this is what all new members are advised during their orientation and safety walk through. The Range (Master) Safety Officer's Word is Final - No Exceptions. If disagreements arise, follow the Range Safety Officers' instructions. Then take any complaint to the Board of Directors, if so desired. A Range Safety Officer may confiscate a membership card for serious rule infractions. The confiscated membership card may be returned at the next Board of Directors' meeting.


