It has been requested that there will be a cease fire on all ranges during the general membership meetings.





Targets will be taped after each shooter at each course of fire. The match requires Rapid fire and Holster draw. Concealment is required of the top half scores (advanced participants). Only stock pistols with stock sights are allowed and they must be concealable. Minimum requirements: Pistol, holster, 3 magazines, a 2 magazine carrier/ pouch, and at least 100 rounds of ammo. -9 mm to 45 cal. 




