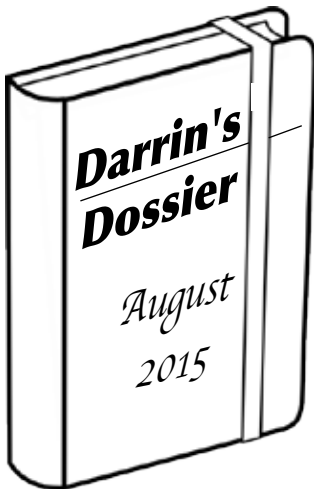
I would like to take this time to thank Patrick Watson, Juli Everett, Tim Geiser and the entire Membership Committee for expediting the new member process and making it more efficient.



(metal stands, wood frames) at 5 to 20 yards. The courses of fire will have various numbers of targets. All targets will be placed so that all shots are downrange. Targets will be taped after each shooter at each course of fire. The match requires Rapid fire and Holster draw. Concealment is required of the top half scores (advanced participants). Only stock pistols with stock sights are allowed and they must be concealable. Minimum requirements: Pistol, holster, 3 magazines, a 2 magazine carrier/ pouch, and at least 100 rounds of ammo. – 9 mm to 45 cal. The targets will be placed between and forward of trap houses 1 and 2. The match is held on the second Saturday each month, 8 am to Noon. Participants must sign up by 7:45 am!!
