It's that time of year when we all start preparing for the holiday season. Please remember to make your donation to the "Toys For Tots" program. You can bring a new, unwrapped toy to the General Meeting, or give it to any of the Range Masters or a member of the Board of Directors. You may also send or bring a cash donation. Please send a check to the Association P.O. Box (printed on this newsletter) with the words "Toys For Tots" printed in the memo space, or you can give cash to any Board member at the meetings.

Members: As most of you know, there has been a lot of rumor floating around in regard to the use of "legal" vs. "not legal" firearms at the Association property. Your Board of Directors has decided the following: Any possession or use of any fully automatic firearm is strictly prohibited on the properties of the Escondido Fish and Game Association. This rule is written into our by-laws and will be enforced fully by our Range Masters, however, it is the opinion of the Board that the usage of any firearm listed as "illegal" by the State of California is and will be the sole responsibility of the owner of said firearm and any registration, documentation or compliance with City, State or Federal laws is as well the responsibility of, and should be in the possession of, the owner of the firearm and will not be enforced by members of the Escondido Fish and Game Association.

As we close out another year, we would like to express our heartfelt thanks to all of our volunteers. We managed, once again, to escape the fate of other, "not so lucky to have as wonderful a staff as we have", shooting facilities. You have made this year another environmentally as well as physically safe and happy place to be. 


