



VOLUNTEER WORK OPPORTUNITIES FOR NEW MEMBERS

EF&GA is planning a series of range improvement projects that have been requested by the members. This is only the beginning of what is hoped to be many significant improvements to our facility. We are organizing committees (and looking for committee leaders) to start these projects. Here are our ideas, so far: -Recover and refurbish the older shooting benches on the 100-yard range.

- -Fabricate and install (locking) expanded metal doors on the wood storage cage. Install a roof over the stored wood, if possible.
- -Build or rebuild the target frame storage kiosks on the pistol and 150-yard ranges. (The kiosk on the 150-yd range is too short to accommodate the taller frames.)

-Rebuild the target butt at the 100-yard distance on the 100-yard range. This butt is below grade and floods during the winter months. As a result, it is beginning to to fall apart.

-Plan and build a privacy fence around our "junk yard", which is adjacent to the north side of the big storage building.

Note that this is by no means an all-inclusive list. The association is constantly looking for ways to improve itself and encourages ideas and suggestions. There is no doubt that other projects will be undertaken as ideas arise. RANGEMASTER SOUND OFF

Halloween is over and with that, the Holiday Season is underway. Thanksgiving is rapidly approaching, with Hanukkah, Christmas, Kwanzaa and New Years' not far behind. Winter begins December 21. Where did 2012 go?

Daylight Savings Time ended last month and the sun sets much earlier. A reminder; the range closes at "local" sunset. Local sunset is when the sun is no longer visible or would no longer be visible when clouds are in the way.

Okay, here we go again. "Targets and Their Placement", a copy of the club policies/rules is posted on the back wall of each range kiosk. There are two items I would like to discuss here:

1) No silhouette targets allowed on the short distance pistol range. Silhouette targets have the capacity to allow bullets to skip and not impact the backstop. The large target area, the entire 24" x 24" target backing becomes a bullet stick area. A great deal of time was put into establishing the short range section. A large portion of that time was spent in determining the target area size. That target size was/ is optimized to where bullets shot at the top or at the bottom of the target backing, will impact the backstop; regardless of shooter height.

Please stay within the stated rule, "Target must be 10 inches square or round, maximum (10 inch maximum envelope size for more than one target) and centered on the 24 inch by 24 inch target backing cardboard. The target backing must be at the top of the target frame".

2. Zombie targets are allowed (except on the short pistol range). Our target rule states "No political figures or likeness of any person living or dead. Paper targets only". If someone has a friend or relative that is or resembles a Zombie, I am truly sorry; but we can shoot 'em.

As some of you have noted, the last bay on the 150 yard range has be closed via "caution tape". This was done to restrict the ability of bullets striking the fence line and oak trees. The backstop berm will be extended in the near future and when complete, we will reopen the last shooting bay. Your patience is appreciated.

Range Safety Tip of the Month. When going down range during a cease fire, it might be a good idea to remove or partially remove you hearing protection. This will allow for commands to be heard if an emergency situation should come to exist. Also, it will allow you to hear a rattle snake if one is in the area. (Thanks to Eric Jamois for the monthly safety tip).




