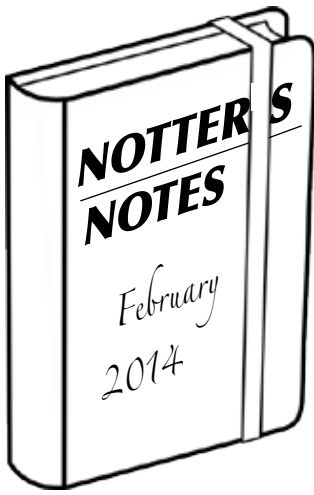

# RANGEMASTER SOUND OFF

I want to start this tome with a reminder to any RSOs who have not received their NRA certification, that a class will be held on February 22 for just that purpose. We will start at approximately 0800 and go to about 1300. This may be your last chance for some time so try to make it.

For one reason or another, range visitors leave gear behind on a regular basis. Don't ask me why. I have done it myself. I found a very nice spotting scope and tri-pod about a week ago (early January). There was no name on it so I secured the scope in the RSO locker under lock and key. If it is yours and you can identify it please let me know. We won't lock up jackets and sweaters, but we will secure the more valuable things left behind. If any member should find equipment left behind, please notify an RSO so that it can be secured until the rightful owner can retrieve it. Certainly, it is the right thing to do.

A First Aid kit is available at each range and in the Meeting Hall. These supplies are available on an "AS Needed" basis to every member and guest who visit the range. If for any reason, you need to use any of the supplies; please let me or any RSO know. We try to monitor the kits to make certain they are properly stocked, however we can do a much better job of it with your help. It is one more way to make the range a safer place for everyone.

We still experience problems with junior members coming to the range to shoot. One or two parents will typically accompany them. The problem arises when the parent wants to shoot also. I am sorry to say that is not allowed. The accompanying adult is only there to supervise the junior(s) shooting. Only youth and regular members are allowed to bring guest shooters to the range. Sorry folks, but the rules will be enforced. Steel core bullets are still a problem. If your ammunition attracts a magnet you will be asked to remove it from the range. Keep in mind that a steel case is not the problem. A young man had a full case, the other day, which looked just fine. The .223 FMJ bullets did not appear to be a problem until they got near a magnet. He now has a full case of ammo that he will have to shoot elsewhere. When you buy your ammo I suggest that you take a magnet with you and save yourself some grief. A quick heads-up. I am looking closely at putting red flashing warning lights that will come on whenever there is anyone down range. I hope to have more on this next month. There will be a bit of a re-write on the range rules if we can make them work, but they should be a significant safety enhancement.
