Dear Members;


A whole new year is upon us, with hopes of great fortune and good health. The BOD and Officers wish each and every one of you a wonderful year. The annual Christmas meeting was enjoyed by all, sharing stories and comradely alike. Because of generosity, you the

members donated in excess of \$2,650 for the Toys for Tots. The Assoc. extends a sincere thanks to Dave and Dottie Ransberger for coordinating this wonderful event. On Sunday the 14th of December, Dave Ransberger, L.T. Reynolds, Linda & John Laniker, Ponytail Bob, and Jason Shaffin gathered at the clubhouse. They assembled 36 bikes and tricycles for the Toy for Tots. Thank you, Linda and gentlemen.

There are some recent changes to the 150-yard range. You will notice the 150yard impact berm is much higher than before thanks to the hard work of John Johnson and Denny Martin. The rocks on the lower end have been covered, thus minimizing the hazard of ricochets. Additionally, the separation berm has been connected with the 150- yard impact berm. This will keep the 150-yard range open to casual shooting while the cowboy and IDPA shoot is being held. The waterway behind the 150 impact berm has been cleaned and water flowed smoothly during the recent rains.

Another important matter needs to be reiterated. There have been numerous association violations regarding members giving the association gate code to non members. Members are giving non-members their membership card, creating a **serious violation of association rules**. These violations are grounds for disciplinary action by the BOD, which ultimately could lead to termination as a member. If such a violation occurs, your membership card will be confiscated immediately. You will then not be allowed on the range until you meet with the BOD. It will be the responsibility of the member to contact the association. We need to take care of our association. You must carry your membership card and a photo ID with you while on the range property. One last item, you are allowed to bring a maximum of two (2) guests with you. You must get written permission to bring additional guests from a BOD. Members are responsible for their guest and must remain with their guest at all times.






