
### **KUDOS**



# RANGEMASTER SOUND OFF



am still getting reports about members bring steel core ammunition, or at least ammunition that attracts a magnet, to the range. The typical response when caught by an RSO is: "Sorry, I didn't know". I am sorry that you spent good money on such ammo. I have some of it myself, but that changes nothing. Save it for the revolution because you cannot use it on the EF&GA range. To help out, I plan to install magnets on each and every shooting bench. When you pull out your ammo the first thing to do is to check and make certain that it passes the magnet test.

Periodically, there are events on the pistol range that make it necessary for the pistol shooters and casual trap shooters to pay a bit more attention to each other than might otherwise be necessary. The pistol range may ask the trap shooters to go "Cold" when changing targets on their 50 yard line. The trap shooters are encouraged to fully accommodate the situation. Having said that, it is the pistol shooters responsibility to make certain that trap shooters are fully aware of their need to go "Cold". A duty RSO should try to make certain that the situation is made as safe as possible. Safety Considerations by the RSO are final.

Another First-Aid class will be scheduled for October 24th. Dr. Osgood has promised to work with us once again. When he and Marshall Goddard team up, we have a first class presentation that is well worth your time. Many of us have a card expiration date close to that class so save the date. Keep me apprised of your interest.






