Clerk. All memberships expire on June 30 every year. New members will begin being admitted on 1 August, taking the place of any members who have chosen not to renew.



NRA Metallic Cartridge Reloading Course

Been wanting to reload your own but didn't know where to start? In the past months there have been numerous requests regarding the availability of a basic reloading class. The opportunity to learn reloading is going to be available on Saturday, June 2nd, 2012 through an NRA certified course here at the EF&GA meeting hall. (This course is not being sponsored by EF&GA.) The NRA Metallic Cartridge Reloading Course will be conducted by Elvio Marchi, an NRA RSO and certified instructor.

NRA course requires that all students present their proficiency with a "hands on" session. To provide the availability of equipment necessary to accomplish this, the class will be divided into two segments.

- 1. The academic portion will be held at the meeting hall on the range, but due to equipment logistics, the hands on portion will be held at a separate location on an agreed upon day.
- 2. The class will be split into smaller groups to facilitate instruction of the "hands on" portion. This portion will be essential for completion of the course...certification cannot be issued without it. The fee will be \$60. A non-refundable \$10 deposit will be required prior to registration. The class size has been limited to 10 individuals so it will be on a first come, first served basis.

Attention Junior Pistol Participants

In our last 3 shoots, our participation has increased from 16 participants in October of 2011, to 44 in April, 2012. **This increase has resulted in issues which must be resolved.** In the interest of safety, and efficiency, our program procedures will be updated, starting with the June 24, 2012 shoot.

- **1.** The age limit for Junior Pistol Shooters will be 12 yrs. to 20 yrs.
- **2.** Participants must be able to handle the association pistols (or their own pistols) safely without props, sandbags, or other supports. We will have an orientation class, starting at 0800, for all participants on the June 24th shoot, and, at all shoots after that, for all first-time shooters. Only those who pass Orientation will be allowed to proceed to the firing line. Those who pass Orientation will be issued a card stating they have passed. Those who do not pass will be able to try again at future shoots until they pass. Those who pass Orientation will not have to repeat the class.
- **3.** On the firing line, there will be only one shooter per coach. There are 16 stations on the Pistol Range. If there are less than 16 coaches, there will be less than 16 shooters. Shooters 15 and older who have participated in at least 3 Junior Pistol shoots may opt to shoot without a coach, but only with the Range Master's approval. These shooters may also serve as coaches for other shooters.
- **4.** Shooters should arrive at the range one hour before their relay, and report to the clubhouse for orientation, and sign-in. I encourage all parents, other adults, and youth shooters to participate as coaches. All our Junior shoots rely on you for support, and cannot function without you. I wish to thank all

The Range needs your help. As noted below, folks have been putting bad bullets in the green cigarette/cigar disposal containers. And continue to do so. Bullet disposal goes in the big, red, iron pipes located on each range. As I told the folks at the 10 May General Meeting, we all need to be aware of this serious problem and if you see someone putting bad bullets in the green containers, help them out by explaining what is proper. Repeating

the past notices follows.

From January 2012

My "What the?" for the month. For some unknown reason, there are a few members, or their guests, that are still damaging our range. While shooting on the pistol range, one of our members' and a RSO heard a loud "pop". They looked to see where it came from and noted the big green cigarette disposal container "smoking" (no pun intended). Upon examination of the containers' contents, Denny Martin removed over 150 bullets. Denny checked the 100 yard and 150 yard range and found approximately 100 more bullets. Some bullets appeared to be misfires and some good. The bullet that "cooked off" was a .22 caliber long rifle; nested in with a whole bunch of small and large caliber bullets. If one of the bigger bullets had exploded, there could have been a serious problem and possibly injuries. It seems some of our Members and their Guests are using the big green cigarette/cigar/tobacco receptacles, those green things with the

big round base, tall neck and the odd shaped top with the hole where the "Butts" go, as a receptacle for misfired or just plain bad bullets. This is not only an unintelligent thing to do, but very unsafe. Please use the big red metal tubes located by the range kiosks for bullet disposal.

From February 2012

My "What the?" for the month. Those of you out there that smoke, please use the green disposal containers. Those of you out there that are not paying attention, the green cigar/cigarette disposal containers are not for discarding bullets. We have already had one bullet "cook off" in one of the green containers and fortunately no one was injured. Use the red cylinders located one each range is for bullet disposal. Using the green "butt" cans for bullet disposal (and maybe a practical joke) is just plain dumb.






