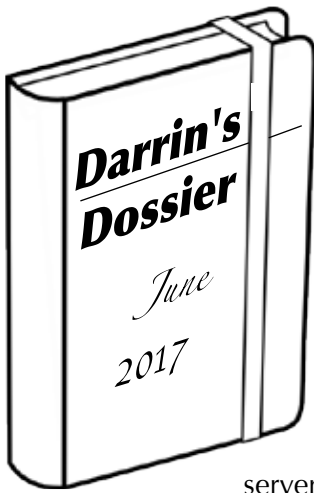

How to place a classified ad in the newsletter

Please help to keep the classified section easy to read and well organized. There is no cost as long as you are an EF&GA member in good standing. Classified ads run for ONE newsletter (one month). If you want to repeat an ad for another month (with price adjustments, etc...) simply re-submit the ad request via e-mail.

Please submit requests for classified ads via email to newsletter@escondidofishandgame.com and be sure to double-check for spelling and grammar errors.

It may sound obvious but requests for classifieds are frequently received with not enough information to be useful to a reader. **There are 5 main components of a classified ad:**

Category – Most classifieds fall into one of 3 categories, 'For Sale', 'Wanted', or 'Lost & Found'.

Subject/Title – This will appear in bold in the advertisement. This should be short (2 or 3 words) and concise.

Description – This is the body of the advertisement and can be a few sentences but not more than a paragraph. Abbreviations appear cryptic and are not recommended unless they are well known acronyms.

Price – A specific dollar amount as well as qualifiers give the reader important information. For example, "\$600 or Best Offer, Buyer pays DROS, Will consider trades"

Contact Info – This should be a name AND a phone number (including area code) and/or an e-mail address.

Rather just than participating in the Junior Marksmanship events, they have become part of the fabric of EF&GA. They are the backbone of our great association that make the events possible. They also inspire us to continue to make the Junior Marksmanship programs bigger and better.

BLACK POWDER NEWS

May will have completed our 2nd Super Short Course shoot. That means our June shoot is going to be the regular Short Course. The targets will be at 50, 75, and 100 yards.

For those of you that might be interested in shooting the Black Powder Silhouette program let me tell you what to expect on the day of the event. On the morning of the event the Shoot Chair will set up the frames and silhouettes starting at 7:00 am. (Volunteer help is appreciated). Shooters will show up to claim a bench and set up their gear around 7:30 am to 8:30 am. All benches are moved to the rear of the range house. When all of the equipment is set, the Shoot Chair will call a brief Hot Range to allow for fouling shots. Starting at 8:30 sign-ups for the pistol/revolver contest will open. During this period the range is called Cold. Pistol/Revolver shooters move their gear out to the designated firing line. At 8:55 the Pistol/Revolver competitors will receive a safety briefing and target assignment. The Pistol/Revolver contest will start at 9:00 and run until completed, (Approx 40 minutes).

All Pistol/Revolver contests are shot standing off/hand, (one or two hand ok). Upon completion of the final Pistol/Revolver relay, all competitors will reset their targets and move their gear/equipment back into the range house. The shoot chair will announce open sign-ups for rifle. At 10:00 am we have a safety briefing and assign targets. All rifle contest are shot standing off/hand without slings or shooting jackets.

Target assignments and round/relay progression is explained below....

Example: Competitor A is assigned target number 3 at 50yds. Competitor B is assigned target number 7 at 75yds, etc.

When the range is called Hot, the competitor walks to the firing line and fires one or two shots at the assigned target.

The competitor records his score on the score sheet. When all competitors are done with the first round the Shoot Chair calls the range Cold. Competitors that hit their silhouette will then walk down range to reset the target for next round.

When all personnel are clear of the range the Shoot Chair calls the range Hot for next round. Competitors then move to the next target distance, fires one or two rounds, and record their score. For example, competitor A shot target number 3 at 50yds in the first round. Targets are reset. For the second round, competitor A moves to target number 3 at 75yds.

Targets are reset. For the third round, competitor A shoots target number 3 at 75yds. This completes one complete Relay.

At the beginning of the Second Relay competitor A moves back to target number 3 at 50 yards.

Three Relays are shot to complete the course. Ties for 1st place are resolved with a shoot-off. Ties for other places are resolved by who had the best score at the longest distance.

Two points are awarded for hitting your target on the first shot. One point is awarded if you missed the first shot, but hit the target on your second shot. If you missed with both shots your score is zero for that round. If you hit somebody else's target on your first shot you don't get points for it. If you hit your target on your second shot you only get one point. If you hit somebody else's target on your second shot you don't get points for it, (and we all give you a bad time). If your target has been shot by somebody else notify the Shoot Chair and you will be assigned a back-up target for that round without penalty.

Firearms Problems: If you have a dry ball, (loaded everything but forgot the powder), or you have ignition problems, (Cap or Flash Pan goes off but the firearm doesn't discharge), Stay on the line with the firearm pointed downrange. Call out for the Shoot Chair or RSO and identify your problem. The Shoot Chair or RSO will assign someone to assist you in clearing the problem. The range will NOT be called cold until the firearm is cleared or called safe. Note that this happens to everybody sooner or later. If you're a new shooter and you don't have the gear to clear your firearm we WILL help you. There is no strict time limit for each round.. The Shoot Chair will call out near the end of each round to determine the number of shooters that need to complete their shots. We are pretty laid back on time. Again, if you need help with something, ASK!

At the completion of the third relay the Shoot Chair, or RSO, will call the range Cold. Ties will be determined and final shoot-offs announced if needed. At the conclusion of the contest all competitors are expected to assist in picking up and putting away the silhouettes and frames that have been used. Once the gear is stored and benches are returned to the firing line, winners will be announced and/or prizes awarded, if any.

It's really pretty simple. Did I mention cheap ?

EF&GA members pay the grand total of \$1 for a pistol entry and \$5 for a rifle entry.

Enough for now. If you have questions about what pistol/revolver, or rifle is legal for entry and/or, what the class requirements are, please contact me.
