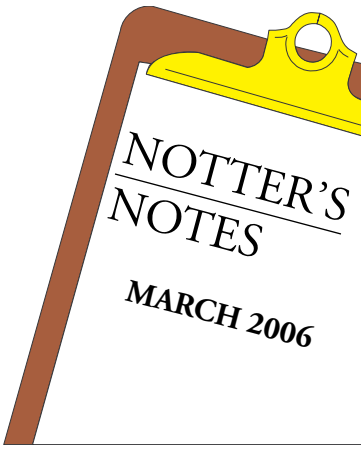

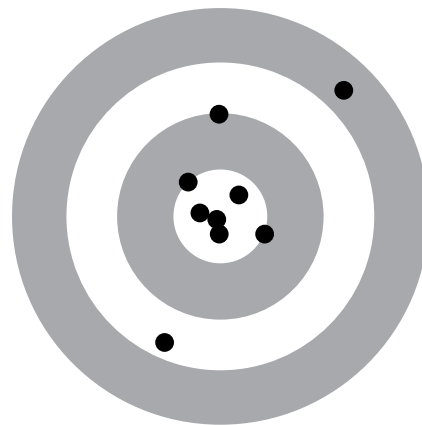

We need your help!

The Escondido Fish and Game Association's junior program was established many years ago and has continued to be a huge success over the years. For years, the program has taught literally hundreds of children the basic principals of marksmanship, sportsmanship and how to safely handle firearms at the Quarterly junior rifle shoots. In the last two years, the Association has also started a monthly junior trap night and most recently, a junior pistol program. Several of our junior members have continued on to compete at different levels all the way up to the Olympics. Our junior members are the future of the shooting sports.

The junior shooting events require a lot of volunteer help to be successful. Many of our current volunteers do not have children involved in the program, but recognize the importance of getting the nation's youths involved in the various shooting sports. Although the ranks of our junior members continue to grow, we have not been as successful in maintaining the number of volunteers needed to organize and run the different junior shoots.

We need volunteers to step up and help the junior program continue to be successful. All types of help are needed, especially coaches. You do not have to be an expert marksman to help the kids learn how to shoot safely and have fun. Someone helping out in the kitchen or scoring the targets is just as important as the coach on the firing line. If the number of volunteers that come out and help at the junior events does not increase soon, the number of junior events per year may have to be cut back due to the lack of help.
