





It is located on the #1 Trap range. See an RSO if you can't find the frame and always check with the RSO before you start shooting on the Trap Range. As a reminder: Know your target and what is beyond -- Keep your finger off the trigger until ready to shoot.

The wild flowers and California Poppies will soon be blooming on the berms thanks to Ray Bucholz. Ray has also planted a rose garden next to the trap Ramada in honor of all our Moms who have passed. Ray (the flower child), you're a good man with a huge heart. Range Officer of the Month is Walt Nicoll.


