**G**reetings All,

You should have already received in the mail an explanation of the proposed Bylaw changes. Please look them over carefully and come and vote on the changes at the March 8th General Meeting. Remember to bring the ballot that was mailed to you, your membership card, and photo identification. Please take an active role in your Assn. by coming to vote. See you there!

We have received the Lease Amendment documents from the City of Escondido, all signed, sealed, and delivered. For those who are wondering what this is about, there were two issues. First is that our lease called for the demolition, and rebuilding of the Trap Ramada. The lease called for this to be completed in February of 2012. The Lease Amendment allows us to keep the old tin shack that the shotgunners love so much. We have agreed to pull a permit to rewire the electrical, put a new roof on the Ramada, and paint it. The second issue is that our fence line overstepped our legal lease line in a few spots by as much as 60+ feet. The Lease Amendment has changed the legal lease line to reflect our fence line. Your Board of Directors is working for you to take care of business.

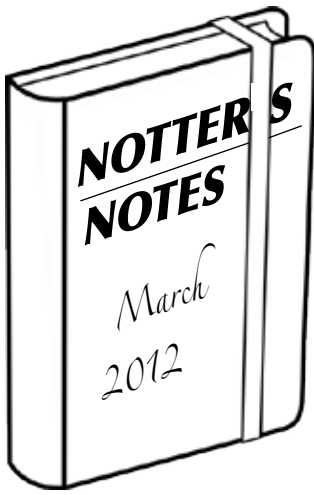
