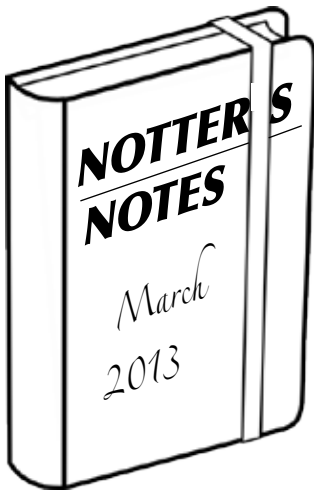

ATTENTION SEMI-AUTO RIFLE ENTHUSIASTS

Come on out on Saturday, April 13, 2013, and join us for our first ever all steel, rapid fire semi-auto rifle match. Bring your AR-15, AK, M1 carbine, or other semi-automatic rifle. Acceptable calibers are .223/5.56, 7.62x39, 30 carbine, 5.56x39, 9mm and 45 ACP. Please NO 308's. Sorry M1A guys! No rimfire, please don't ask. Please note that all rifles must comply with California law. Also, no steel core or armor piercing ammunition is allowed. The course of fire will be four, 18 round stages, so bring about 100 rounds of ammunition. Distances are 50 to 100 yards. Shooters will need in addition to their rifles, 3 mags and 2 mag pouches or cargo pants to hold their mags. Also, bring a bipod if you have one. Remember: Bring your hearing and eye protection.

RANGEMASTER SOUND OFF

Reminder, get your picture taken for the new Membership Proximity Card. Come 01 July, If you do not have a new card, it will be really difficult to enter the Range.

March is a busy month for us at the range. Daylight Savings Time begins Sunday, 10 March. Clocks move ahead one hour and we have more daylight at the end of the day. Spring begins Wednesday, 20 March. Passover begins Monday, 25 March, Good Friday is 29 March and Easter happens Sunday, 31 March.

Range Safety Officers and fellow members please take note. The following is taken from our range rules “Targets and their placement” which is posted on the back of each range kiosk and part of every new members welcome packet.

The five, seven and ten yard distances on the Pistol Range.

“Target must be 10 inches square or round maximum (10 inch maximum envelope size for more than one target) and centered on the 24 inch by 24 inch target backing cardboard. The target backing must be at the top of the target frame. **No silhouettes allowed.** Target placement is designed to keep bullets impacting the backstop. Also, check to make sure your bullets make it to the backstop. The rules are posted nearby and all normal range rules apply; i.e., no rapid fire, no draw from a holster, etc.” Note the statement “10 inch maximum envelope size for more than one target”. This means that your target or targets must reside within a 10 inch envelope. The envelope is not defined by shape. You can put one, two, three or more targets on the target backing as long as they reside within a 10 inch envelope. The envelope can be square or circular and in the center of the 24” x 24” target backing, and no silhouettes. I have made note before that if targets are placed low on the target backing, an opportunity exists for bullets to strike the ground and leave the range. Not good.

Changing direction, I would like to start a dialog regarding the Archery Range. I am starting off with the basics as I understand them and will offer more in the future. First up, some basic rules:

1. When arriving on the Archery range to practice, sign-in at the Pistol Range, note “A” in the Range Bo.
2. Stay behind the red shooting line while the Archery Range is Hot.
3. Keep arrows in your quiver until you are ready to shoot.
4. Always wear arm guard and finger tabs.
5. Always keep arrows pointed down or toward the target.
6. Always release a drawn bow with an arrow nocked on the string. Dry firing can damage the bow.
7. Shoot at targets only.
8. Always walk on the archery range.

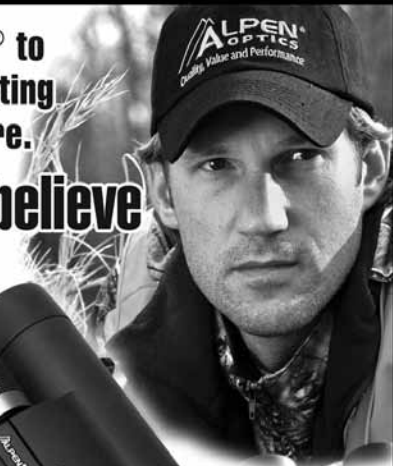
