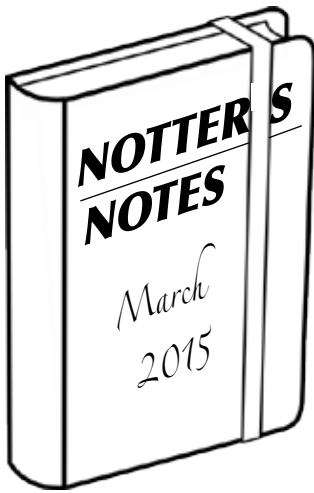
KUDOS



RANGEMASTER SOUND OFF

If anyone cares to look, they will find a series of safety rules along with various administrative rules for Escondido Fish and Game Association. Administration rules such as “The Range Hours are from 0700 to local Sunset” should be understood to mean sunset at the range not the sunset time you saw in the newspaper. There is a difference and in the winter it may mean that you have less time to shoot than you anticipated.

There are other rules that tell you the speed limit on the range, make sure the gate closes behind you and be aware that other cars have a tendency to follow you in through the gate. Should that happen it is the members’ responsibility to insure that the following car is authorized to be on the range.


Another rule is that each member is to have a current I.D. Badge in their possession and visible to any RSO or other member who wishes to see it. Unfortunately, while we have had key cards for about two years now, there are still members who have not taken the time to get the new badges with a photo on it. Even though they are paid members they will not be able to access the range because the old cards do not allow it. Any RSO who encounters one of these badges is authorized to take the badge and return it to the Association Clerk. The member will then be denied further access to the range until the Clerk is contacted and arrangements for the new badge are made.

Numerous range safety rules are to be observed, but those which involve loaded firearms while people are downrange are counted as particularly important. There is no excuse for that kind of negligence. There been several instances of this happening of late and all RSOs are being encouraged to create an incident report or contact report whenever it happens. The BOD has given me direction to handle such violations at my discretion. Violators should not be surprised to find they are banned from the range until they have completed a safety walk through which I will personally conduct.

As mentioned earlier our safety rules are posted and readily available. If cannot find a copy let me know and I will be happy to email one to you. Our rules are not always the same as other ranges simply because our local situation may require it. The point being that assuming you know the rules may sometimes pose a problem.

We all love our firearms, but we must all understand that they can be dangerous if not handled properly. Most of the safety rules, written or unwritten, are actually fairly simple. If looks dangerous, it probably is so don’t do it. Think it through and use common sense. Teach your kids to do the same thing.

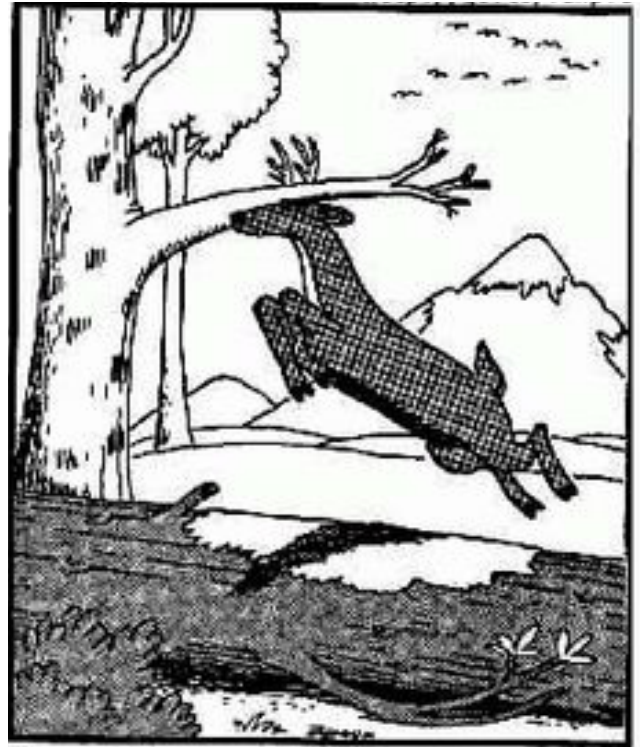

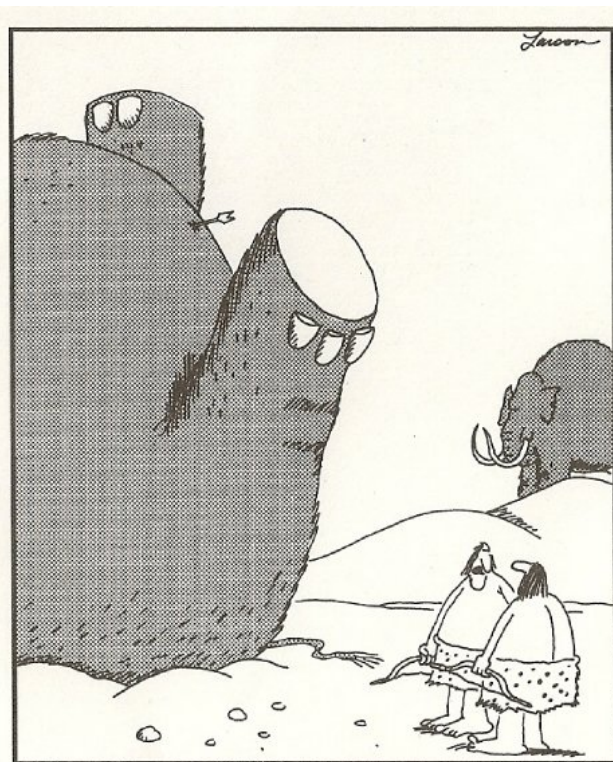

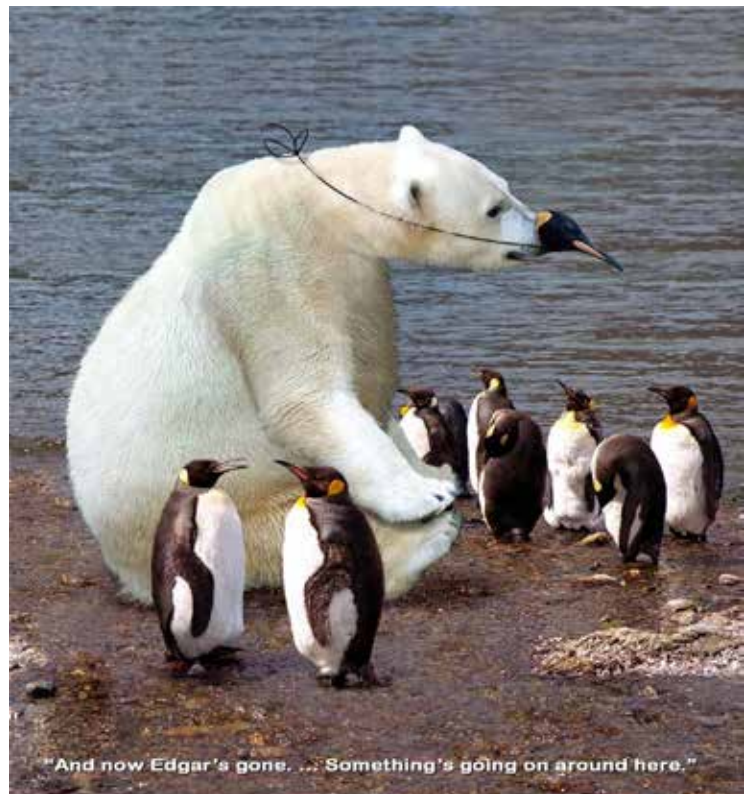
