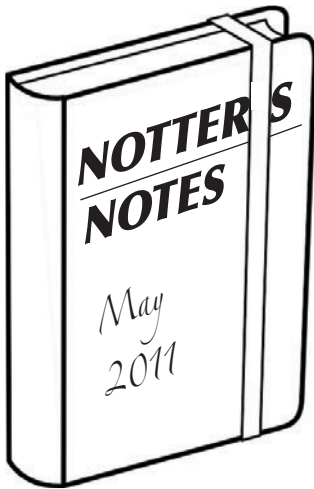

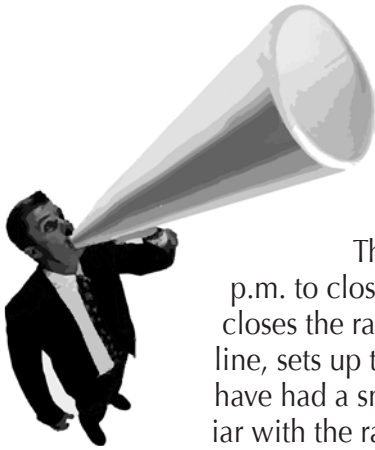

RANGEMASTER SOUND OFF

As you have read in past issues of our Newsletter, “Short Range Pistol Practice” (SRPP) has been going for a few weeks now and I thought I would give you a brief update.

The “Short Range Pistol Practice” (SRPP) sessions are on Tuesday afternoons from 1:00 p.m. to closing. The Range Safety Officer that signs-up for the SRPP is dedicated to that session, closes the ramada area of the pistol range, sets up the 5, 7 and 10 yard shooting lines at the 50 yard line, sets up the target stands and monitors the range shooting session. The target shooting sessions have had a small turn-out lately but I think that will change with time and more folks become familiar with the range shooting. I have participated a couple of times and found the shooting informative.

For SRPP to be active, two Range Safety Officers’ are required; one for SRPP and one for the rest of the range. If there is one dedicated on-duty Range Safety Office set up to run SRPP and there is no second Range Safety Officer to monitor the rest of the range, SRPP will be shut down and the RSO will work the entire range and normal pistol shooting will be allowed.

As you may know, the Association has an internet site dedicated to our Range Safety Officers’, www.efgarso.org. Anyone may visit this site. Lee Allen and Jay Zimmert have been “burning the midnight oil” setting the site up and running functional tests. The last piece to the internet site puzzle has been setting up an interactive calendar that will allow the Range Safety Officers’ to schedule shifts and make change if necessary. They have enlisted volunteers to work with the calendar checking functionality and getting the instructions finalized. As some of you may know, getting an interactive calendar to satisfy our needs has not been easy.

Once the internet site calendar is finalized, the green sign-up books located in the Trap Ramada will no longer be used. I expect that we will be able to “go live” with the calendar this coming July. Those Range Safety Officers’ that have been using the interactive calendar have had favorable comments on its use. Kenneth Notter will still publish the monthly RSO duty schedule in the Newsletter. Lee Allen will still publish the “RSO Needed” calendar. The current months’ “Range Schedule” calendar, “RSO Duty” calendar and the “RSO Needed” calendar will still be put up in the kiosk at each range.

At the 07 April Board of Directors meeting, spouse membership was discussed. Currently, when someone joins the Association, they must attend a Safety Briefing and Range Walk-About. The new member can indicate their spouse as being a member and membership was given to both, even though the spouse may not have attended a Safety Briefing session. With the Associations’ new fiscal year starting in July, spouse membership will require that they attend a Safety Briefing and Range Walk-About, prior to a membership card being issued to the spouse.

Range Safety Tip of the Month. Two guests maximum per member; for more, written permission is required in advance from the BOD (Board of Directors). E-mail the Association Secretary for permission. The Secretary will e-mail you back and you must have that e-mail, in hard copy form, with you while at the range. You are responsible for your guest(s) and you must stay with your guest at all times while on our property (the only exception would be a trip to the restroom). Kids must stay with adults at all times even in the primitive camping area.

Regarding the shooting rule stating “two targets placed vertically”, we do allow four 9 inch (approximate diameter) paper plates clustered in the center of the 24 inch by 24 inch cardboard target backing.
