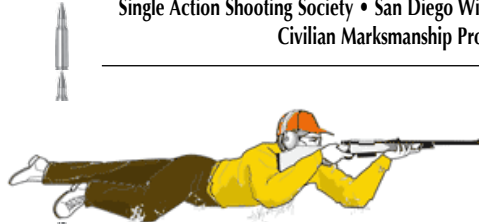

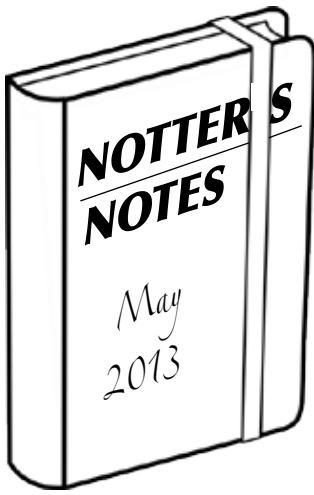
RANGE CLEANUP AND WORK PARTY ON SAT. MAY 18TH

NRA METALLIC COURSE CARTRIDGE RELOADING

The opportunity to learn how to reload is available Saturday, April 6th, 2013 at the EF&GA meeting hall. This course is a certified NRA reloading course (not sponsored by EF&GA). The NRA Metallic Cartridge Reloading Course will be conducted by Elvio Marchi, an NRA certified instructor. This NRA course will require that all students prove their proficiency with a "hands on" session for certification. In order to provide the accessibility to equipment necessary to accomplish this, the class will be divided into two segments. The academic portion will be held at the meeting hall on the range from 8:00 A.M. to Noon, but due to equipment logistics, the hands on portion will be held at a separate location on an agreed upon day and hour. The class will be split into smaller groups to facilitate instruction of the "hands on" portion. This portion will be essential to completion of the course...certification cannot be issued without it. The fee will be \$65 (\$80 for individuals w/o supplies) for those individuals that have their own supplies (cases, powder, primers,

projectiles and dies). Various caliber dies are available for use...check with Elvio on caliber availability. A non-refundable \$20 deposit will be required prior to registration. Class size is limited to 10 individuals. Please contact Elvio at elvio1@cox.net or 760-734-3942 if you have an interest in learning to reload.

BASIC SHOTGUN COURSE AND LEARNING TO HIT A MOVING TARGET-

This class covers firearm safety and basic skills of Shotgunning. It is also designed to train the student the proper skills required to hit a moving target. The NRA Certified Shotgun Course teaches stance, gun ready position, swing to target, trigger pull, and follow through. The class consists of classroom exercises and hands-on instruction including live fire exercise through which students will learn and demonstrate safe and proper shotgun shooting procedures and technique. Hands on range time will include techniques required for shooting and hitting moving targets-(Trap). Upon successful class completion students will receive the NRA Basic Practical Rocker
