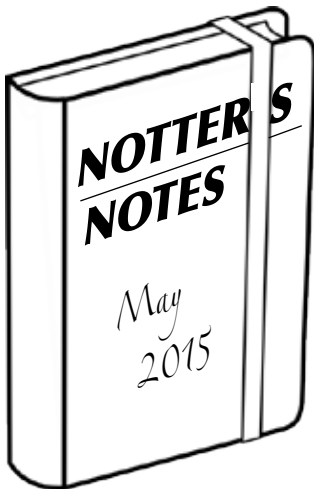



Course teaches stance, gun ready position, swing to target, trigger pull, and follow through. The class consists of classroom exercises and hands-on instruction including live fire exercise through which students will learn and demonstrate safe and proper shotgun shooting procedures and technique. Hands on range time will include techniques required for shooting moving targets- (Trap). Upon successful class completion students will receive the NRA Basic Practical Rocker and an NRA Basic Shotgun Certificate. Classes are limited to 10 Students. NRA METALLIC CARTRIDGE RELOADING CLASS JUNE 6, 2015

Here is your opportunity to receive NRA certified reloading instruction in a two session class. The First Part is strictly academic and conducted at the EF&GA meeting hall from 12 – 4 pm. The Second Part will be a “Hands On” reloading bench experience on Elvio’s reloading bench. The second session will be scheduled at the 1st session. EF&GA members = \$85; non-members = \$95. For students without reloading supplies (empty cases, powder, primers, etc.) a \$10 surcharge will be applied. A \$20 deposit is required to secure a place in this class. Registration is limited. ALL STEEL AR-15 RIFLE/PISTOL MATCH

Come on out every third Saturday, of every month except May and November, and join us for our all steel, rapid fire AR-15 rifle and handgun match at 7:30 a.m. at the 150 yard range. Bring your AR-15, AK, or other semi-automatic

rifle. Please, No 308’s. Also bring your semi-auto or revolver handgun. NO RIMFIRE GUNS. Please note that all rifles must comply with California law. Also, no steel core or armor piercing ammunition is allowed. Make sure your ammo passes the magnet test.

The course of fire will be one 18 round prone rifle stage, and three 36 round off hand Rifle and handgun stages. Please bring at minimum 72 rounds for your rifle and minimum 60 rounds for your hand gun. Rifle targets are placed at 50 to 150 yards. Handgun targets are placed at 15 to 20 yards. All targets are steel. Shooters will need 3 magazines and at least 2 mag pouches for their rifle and handgun. Rifle slings are required. This is an open match. Scopes and red dot sights OK. Match cost is \$5 for members and \$10 for non-members. For more info contact Brian Lamb gunner9mm@att.net

RANGEMASTER SOUND OFF

As I write there are arrows, shotgun paraphernalia, a rifle stick, and a bunch of other stuff the RSOs have found on the range and secured for their owners. The problem is that the owners seem to think their stuff has disappeared and have never tried to reclaim it. Storage space is running out so here is the new policy; when items are picked up on the range they will be secured with the pick-up date on them. With the exception of firearms, the secured items will start showing up on the raffle table at the general meeting. Remember that just because you left an item at the range, it does not mean that someone made off with it!

I have completed an update on the range manual. It was primarily intended for use by the RSOs, but by no means is the General membership not privy to it. I am more than happy to send an email file to any member who requests it. The rule and policies that govern our range use should be read and understood by each and every member. I strongly encourage each of you to go over them on a routine basis.


On each of the ranges there are Butt kits and Dud Containers. The formers are plastic and **Green in color**. The latter are made of heavy metal tubing and are **Red in color**. **These containers are not interchangeable!** Recently we have found that some people seem to think they are and we have found live rounds in the **Butt Kits** and **Butts** in the **Dud Containers**. This is not acceptable and using them incorrectly can lead to serious consequences. If you are color blind or cannot distinguish between plastic and heavy steel tubing please check with someone before using either of them!

At the risk of repeating myself, the recent lack of rain has not improved the risk of fire and there is no reason that it will improve much in the foreseeable future. All of our actions at the Range should be conducted with the possibility of fire in mind. Each member and RSOs in particular, are strongly encouraged to review what actions should be taken in the event of a fire. The Range Manual covers our safety plan in great detail. Read it, read it, read it!

While it is the responsibility of each new member to get in their volunteer time before membership renewal, I am well aware that there are a number of you who have been a bit remiss to date. Clean-up, the Saturday before our annual barbeque, is a good time to make it happen. The BOD will not look kindly on those of you who “did not have time”. This is a volunteer organization and we need your help. Come to the next general meeting to find what other options are available to you. We need help to pull off the Barbeque event also. Do your part to keep this one of the finest ranges around.

Last but not least Membership renewal is coming up. Don't forget. If for some reason you misplace the renewal letter or do not get one (highly unlikely), be sure to check with the Association clerk. Juli Everett will get you squared away in a hurry.
