New Lease!

Hello Everyone,

This month I have great news! I just came from City Hall where I handed the new Real Property

Manager, Ann Marc'arelle, the final signed copy of the new lease.

The key points in this lease are as follows:

- Twenty-year extension addition to the time left on the existing lease. This would put us out to November of 2037. That's 30 years!
- At that point, we have an option of extending the lease for another 20 years. That's 50 years all total.
- We have an additional 8.12 acres of land which puts us over 12 acres all total.

Looking back through my records, we started this process in July of 2003. It has been a long hard road but we did it. I have already received emails from members stating that this is quite the accomplishment. I want to thank everyone, especially my committee for all the hard work and perseverance.

We will notify you on what our next steps will be. The course of action will be directed by the board and acquire your approval since this requires a by-law change.

Next, we contracted the installation of the gate controller and motor with Frontier Fence. It will be installed within the next two weeks. We will also re-asphalt the front entry to protect the new electrical loops that control the gate. I know a lot of you have been waiting for this and I am very pleased about getting it done.

Linda Linaker has chosen to resign her board position. Linda has gone through some very difficult times lately with the loss of her father and needed some time off. We wish her well and thank her for her services. The board elected Ed Migdal to finish out her term. In addition, Raymond Hug has resigned as treasurer. He also needed a break. Ray Osgood will perform the Treasurer's duties until the board appoints a new treasurer to finish out Hug's term.

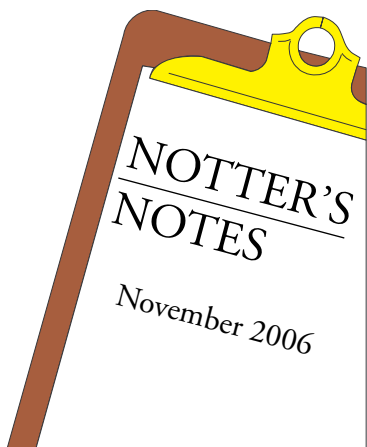

ANOTHER SUCCESSFUL JUNIOR SHOOT

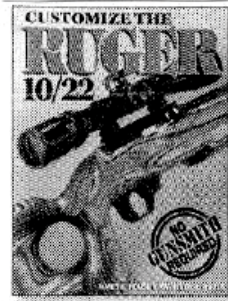

LEGISLATIVE NOTES

Governor Schwarzenegger vetoed two bills of interest to gun owners and shooters. AB2714 would have put severe restrictions on buying ammo by mail and would have allowed local Governing bodies to restrict ammo sales and delivery. SB 59 would have made it an infraction to not report the theft of a gun within five days and would have repealed the provision that bans local governing bodies from passing restrictive laws.

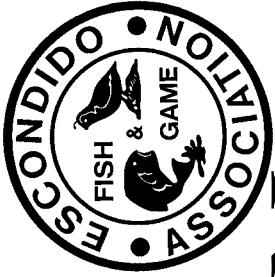

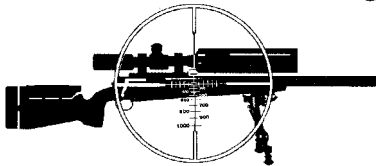
