PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Hi Everyone,

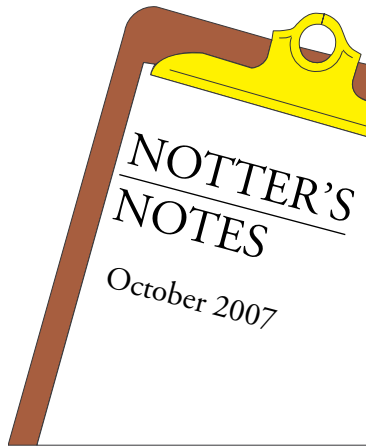
I just want to remind everyone of a few things. A few of you including Range Masters have brought to my attention some safety items and I will pass them along to all members:

- 1) Safety is our main concern! On the rifle range a shooter had eight targets on his target frame. From the bench position he was shooting at the bottom four targets and naturally the bullets hit the ground before reaching the impact area sending the bullet over the berm. (The shooter was a guest – those who bring a guest are responsible for the safe shooting of the guest). Another occurrence on the rifle range occurred when a member was shooting at his target which was two positions to the right of his position. This sent the projectile into the wall above the 100 yard line on the right.
- 2) On the pistol range when shooting rapid fire the bullets are hitting the cement at the 15 yard line. Again this sends the bullet up and over the berm. And if you have observed the target frames they are getting shot up pretty fast, so slow your firing – you will get better results.
- 3) All firing ends at sun down. Not when it gets dark and you can't see your target.
- 4) The only time rifles are allowed on the pistol range is during a sanctioned match.
- 5) No drawing from a holster behind or in front of the firing line on the pistol or rifle range.
- 6) And last but not least – **clean up the Trap Ramada after you use it, turn off the lights and close the door.**
- 7) One more item. The Association does not need your furniture discards. If you believe that the Association can use your item, bring your idea to the Board of Directors meeting on the first Thursday of each month or email a list of items you believe EF&GA might have a need for to the secretary or myself.

Thank you for attention on these items. Remember, Safety Is Our Main Concern!

Proposed Improvements

As Stipulated in the New Lease

Effective 2/1/07

Recommended Priority List; per the committee as of 3/07

1. – Install new perimeter fencing in areas of expansion to preserve security and safety for the public, subject to City approval of design and finished construction.
2. - Additional perimeter signs.
3. - Replace covered pistol shooting area on concrete slab to include baffles in order to insure rounds penetrate the bank.
4. - Add accessibility to pistol and rifle ranges for handicap.
5. - Create an unimproved primitive tent camping ground in the wooded area for members and club-sanctioned outings. Also create a secondary access to the range for safety reasons. No recreational vehicles will be allowed in the camping area. This will be a dry camp area only.
6. - Increase electrical service capacity.
7. - Additional lighting for safety.

The following are on the list but in no particular priority order:

- A. - Expand the well capacity
- B. - Build permanent restroom facilities.
- C. - Landscape and tree planting
- D. - Demolish wood framed corrugated metal building (Trap Ramada). Rebuild with wood framed building wrapped with stucco to match existing structures.
- E. Construct a wood framed exterior stucco structure approximately 20' x 200' to replace all the various containers to serve as a storage unit and mechanics shop.
- F. - Construct a new covered rifle shooting area with concrete slab to create longer shooting range and assure rounds to impact the bank.
- G. - Construct a new clubhouse in the expanded property area as well as a gravel parking lot to accommodate large functions. NOTE: This item would depend highly on the membership approval as a need.

The committee also suggested:

Instead of a work building; install a doublewide Mobil home on the site.
Instead of wood buildings, install steel buildings.

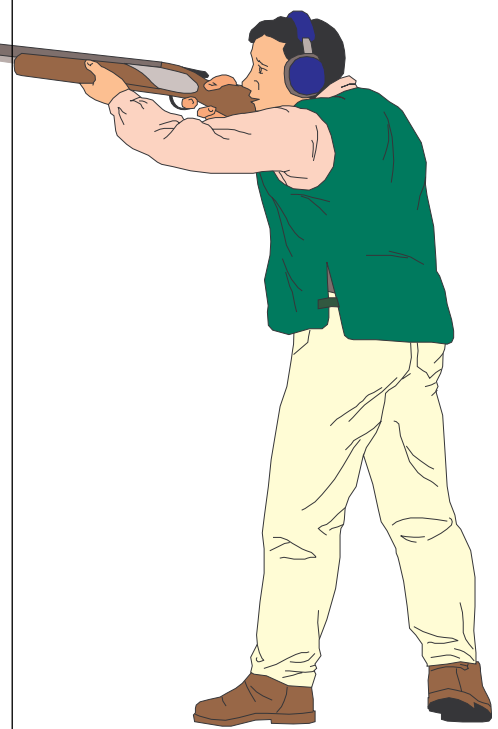

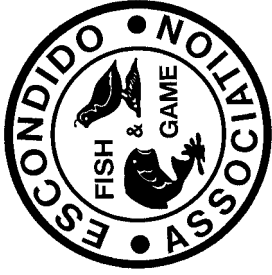

"Draw and fire" is not allowed at any range, unless it is an association sanctioned event or the shooter has WRITTEN permission from the Board

The gate combination is to never be given out to any non-member. Anyone who has not gotten their new membership card because of late renewal is considered to be a non-member until they receive their new membership card. DO NOT GIVE THE GATE COMBINATION TO ANYONE. Everyone who needs to have it has it already.

They give us an indication of when the use of the facility is heaviest, which makes it easier to schedule events that won't conflict with casual shooting during the busier times as well as maintaining safety records for our insurance company. Thank you all for your cooperation with this.
