Attendance Prize

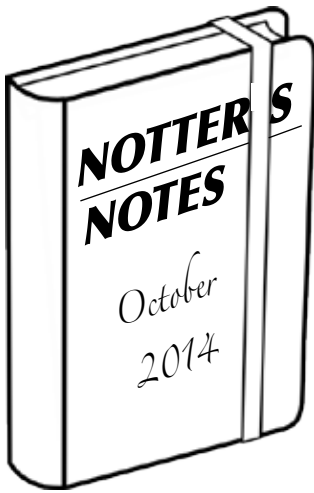



My greatest fear is that I will die and my wife will sell my guns for what I told her I paid for them! My second fear was that I would run out of material to write this column each month. The first has not occurred yet and thanks to you all neither has the second!

Downrange lights have received some criticism for not being bright enough. I am working to resolve it. Other members seem to think the lights are dumb and a waste of time and money. Any attempt to improve range safety is, to me, potentially a valid expenditure. I have gotten significantly more favorable comments than negative comments regarding the lights, but I assure you I am always searching for a better way. In the meantime some members will simply have to learn how to turn a switch on or off!

The Man- Gate Codes have been changed in some cases. Some of the codes will be made available only to RSO's and are located in the RSO Range Book. Others are reserved only for use by designated club personnel.


I normally try to keep upbeat somewhat, but truth be told ,the last Range Clean-up was abysmal turnout. I admit that it was a hot day, but give me a break guys! Less than 35 people showed up! There was one young lady of about fourteen who showed up and worked like a stevedore, she put us all to shame. Thank you Brooke.

Shortly after entering the main gate you may have noticed a rather new sign that says "Stop" until Gate Closes. This is not really a suggestion. It means STOP. Make certain the gate has begun to close and insure that unauthorized visitors have not followed you in!

Silhouettes still seem to be an issue and I would like to put that issue to rest. None are allowed without exception on the short pistol range. Silhouettes are allowed on the rest of the pistol range and both long gun ranges. Silhouette targets, along with any other target used must fit within the 24"x24" target backing on the frames. If it extends beyond the backing, the target is not legit and you will be asked to remove it.. There are reports of a smattering of targets depicting big muscular, he man types that seem to bear a strong resemblance to your CRSO. Now, they may be legit, but really! I have not had a mustache for years.

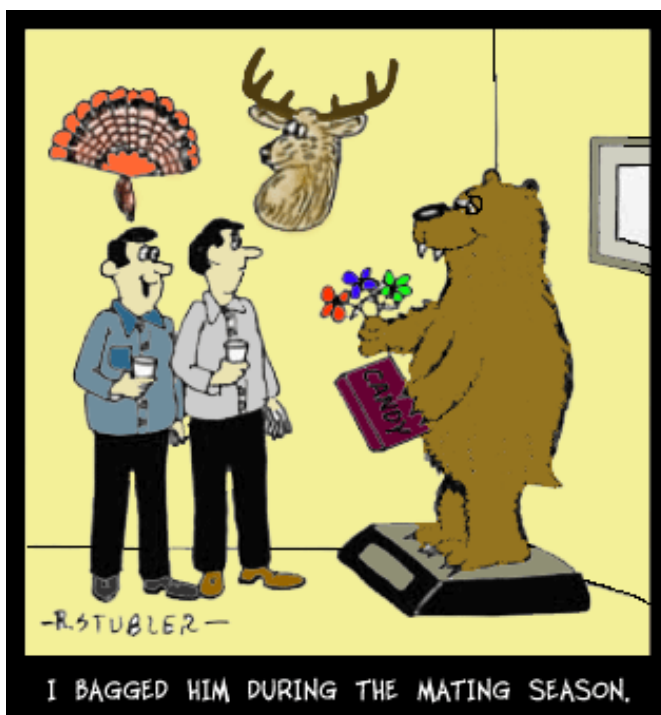
