
Kudos



RANGEMASTER SOUND OFF

or some reason there remains some confusion regarding bringing guests to the range. Since I go over the subject on a regular basis, I can only come to two conclusions; first my column is boring and unreadable, but we all know that cannot possibly be the case. Secondly, many members simply do not read the rules or pay attention.

The rule is that each member may take two guests. If the wife is a card carrying member she and her husband may each take two guests. If the spouse does not have a card and comes along she is considered a part of the guest count. It makes no difference whether the guest is a shooter or an observer. An exemption can be made for another guest by sending an email to our Club Secretary Geoff Orchin with such a request. A copy of his response must be in your possession when you come to the range. Without it your party or the extra guest(s) may be asked to leave the range. Our Secretary has always been quite generous in allowing an extra person, but he maintains our calendar and the Board has designated him to be the gate keeper.

Harry Fagan was nominated as the RSO of the year for 2015. Harry has been a dedicated RSO for many years and has been a major asset for the Club every year. It was a hard choice actually because there are many RSOs who spend a lot of time helping to keep our Club a safe and orderly. I hope each and every RSO who shows up for duty knows that their efforts are noted and appreciated.

Once again keep in mind that the next 1st aid class will be held on October 24th. If your card is expiring or about to, let me know ASAP if you wish to participate in the class.

When coming into the range there are signs that tell you to stop and wait for the gate to close. Please keep in mind that you should use the same procedure when leaving the range. Unless the gate is locked open for a special event open to the public, always follow this procedure.

Last, but not least an RSO may sometimes issue what we call a contact sheet to a member. We are not policemen and this should not be construed as a warning ticket. I cannot be at the range personally at every moment. As much as anything this is a means of letting me and ultimately the BOD know what is going on. Remember what I said about "Rules" earlier? Some work, some do not and the dynamics of running a safe and effective range means that we have to stay on top on things to the greatest extent possible.




