## PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Dear Members,

On 15 August 2007, a letter was sent to all voting members of the association. We are asking that you give the Board of Directors authorization to release funds from the Range

Fund to the Range Improvement fund. This is in accordance with the By-Laws of the association.

If you can remember back far enough, the purpose of the range fund was to buy a piece of property for a range that we could call our own. (The association currently leases the land we are on from the City of Escondido). Although we looked at several pieces of property and that would have been good sites, as soon as the owner and or property manager found out that we wanted it for a rifle and pistol range negotiations ceased. They didn't want us in the area.

So, as the range fund purpose was to purchase a piece of property, this will not happen. So we are asking the members to vote to move the money from the Range Fund to the Range Improvement Fund. If this action is approved by the association members we can go ahead with the improvements.

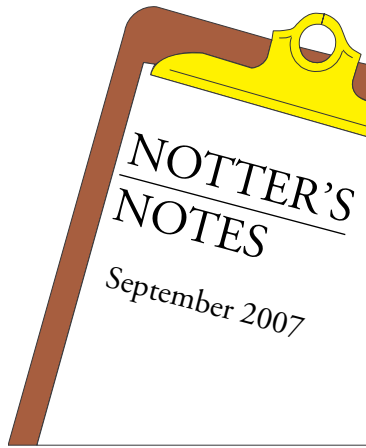

Some of the improvements I have heard are: new running water bath room facilities, berms for the 200 yard rifle range (this is a must), and baffles for the pistol range, new trap Ramada, etc, etc. As I said in my last news letter, all this will take time. But with your help and understanding it will be accomplished.

The Board of Directors and my self are open for any suggestions to improve the range.

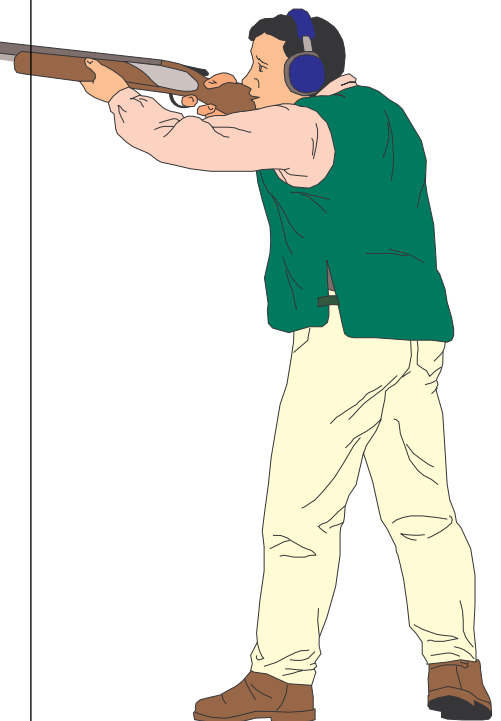

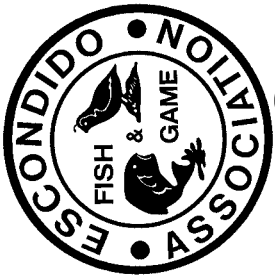

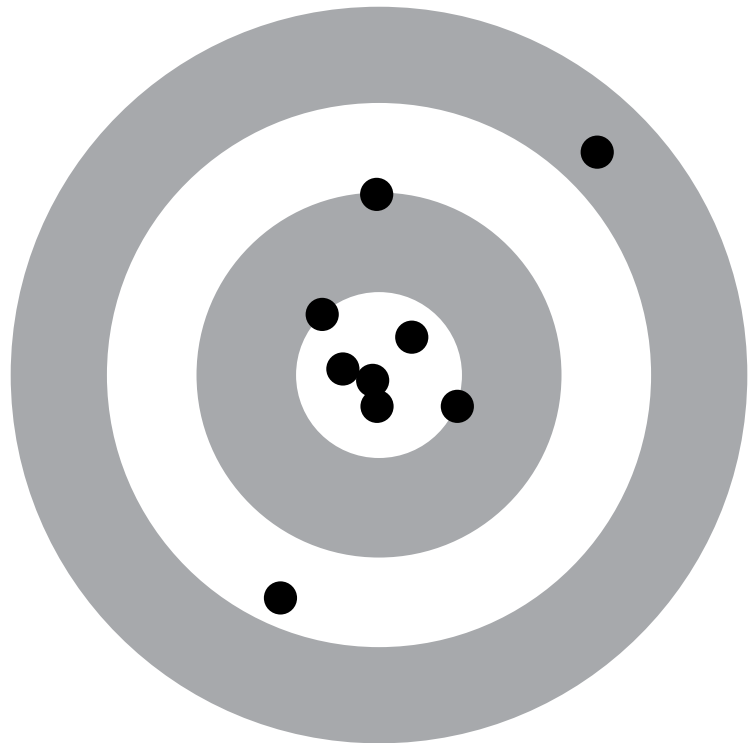
