

# Problems Become Opportunities



He spent 23 years in the Marine Corp and retired at Master Sgt. He was an Infantry scout sniper and became a weapons instructor for basic infantryman and scout snipers. Spent 7 years as a PMC recruit instructor and three years on the summer Marine Corp rifle team. And if that wasn't enough he received his Distinguished marksmanship award #1,263 in 1996. Mr. Ren Everett has been running the Jr. Rifle program for quite a while now and it shows. He knows exactly what is going on and got the process of setting up and taking down to a science. All of the Coaches and volunteers know exactly where and when to set things up and take them down because of, all of the hard work that Mr. Ren has done over the years to make things better and more efficient by creating diagrams and other solutions to make everything go back the same way as it was taken out. Since Mr. Ren has taken over the Jr. Rifle program regularly tops out with a class of 70 80 shooters every other month if daylight permits. I don't know what his secret Krabbie Pattie formula is but it seems to work and it is a fun program that teaches our youth the fundamentals of safety and introduces them to the world of firearms.

Not only is Mr. Ren there at the range for Jr. Rifle but he also does the black powder shoots regularly, and if you've ever been to the Range BBQ you'll see him there on the pistol range helping people by loading the powder and the patch and ball and then letting them shoot the rifle and feel what its like to shoot a primitive rifle. No matter whether you are a Junior or an adult Mr. Ren always tries to help out wherever he can.

He was also one of the big reasons why the Junior coaches are around, without his support and letting us try out the idea at Jr Rifle, we probably wouldn't exist and It would have only been an idea that myself and Patrick Russ had. So on behalf of all the Junior Coaches and Jr shooters, I would like to thank you for the opportunity to learn and grow in our own skills, and the opportunity to help those Jr's that didn't know how to shoot grow in their ability to shoot well, have fun and most of all be safe around Firearms at all times.

# RANGEMASTER SOUND OFF

By being considerate of other shooters and paying close attention to the rules of the range conflicts can easily be avoided. Range conduct can also be described as "Range Etiquette". For example: make certain that everyone on the line is ready when a "cold range" cease fire is called. Otherwise a shooter might easily be caught with a half full magazine or loaded firearm when it is not necessary. However, an emergency "CEASE FIRE" can be called at any time for any reason the caller sees a safety concern! Remember that everyone is wearing ear protection so make range commands loud enough for all to hear.

Speaking of rules....this is the time of year that we bring in new members. A part of our induction process is to introduce you to our range rules, both safety and administrative. Every club member is supposed to be familiar with those rules, but new members possibly even more so. You have all the latest updates and as a new member, I should think, the incentive to learn and take them to heart. I keep a full copy on my night stand for a 2AM review whenever I cannot sleep. The least you can do is to review the range rules every time you come to the range! As always, I am happy to email a full copy of our RSO Safety Manual to any member who makes the request. You wives reading this keep it in mind. What a wonderful and thought full Xmas /Birthday present for hubby!

Any RSO who has not received a name badge, please let me know by email. They are one of those little chores that fall through the cracks once in a while. I will get one made as quickly as possible. I will place them in the small "RSO BOX" by the front door of the meeting hall. Check whenever you are at the range. They will show up eventually.

Our uniquely clever member, Darrin Eaton, has taken on the challenge of revising the RSO web page to make it less complicated to use. Quite frankly any change at all will be more than welcome. For the time being just remember that if you were unable to sign up for an RSO shift, simply check the bulletin for "RSO NEEDED", come on up, sign in and assume the shift. # How to place a classified ad in the newsletter

Please help to keep the classified section easy to read and well organized. There is no cost as long as you are an EF&GA member in good standing. Classified ads run for ONE newsletter (one month). If you want to repeat an ad for another month (with price adjustments, etc...) simply re-submit the ad request via e-mail.

Please submit requests for classified ads via email to newsletter@escondidofishandgame.com and be sure to double-check for spelling and grammar errors.

It may sound obvious but requests for classifieds are frequently received with not enough information to be useful to a reader. There are 5 main components of a classified ad:

**Category** – Most classifieds fall into one of 3 categories, 'For Sale', 'Wanted', or 'Lost & Found'.

**Subject/Title** – This will appear in bold in the advertisement. This should be short (2 or 3 words) and concise.

**Description** – This is the body of the advertisement and can be a few sentences but not more than a paragraph. Abbreviations appear cryptic and are not recommended unless they are well known acronyms.

**Price** – A specific dollar amount as well as qualifiers give the reader important information. For example, "\$600 or Best Offer, Buyer pays DROS, Will consider trades"

**Contact Info** – This should be a name AND a phone number (including area code) and/or an e-mail address.
